# The Warren Center

Offering two event locations, The Warren Center is the premiere location for a wedding in this region, offering unforgettable views of Lake Junaluska and the Blue Ridge and Great Smoky Mountains. Have your ceremony on the event lawn and reception inside.

Ceremony seating up to 200 guests.

# **MEMORIAL CHAPEL**

Situated lakeside, Memorial Chapel features Gothic architecture with a beautiful stone exterior and more than 25 lovely stained glass windows.

Reception seating up to 220 guests.



# **INSPIRATION POINT**

A stone overlook surrounded by a beautiful garden sits outside historic Lambuth Inn. Inspiration Point provides panoramic views of the Lake Junaluska Cross and majestic mountain landscape.

Ceremony seating up to 85 guests.



# **AMPHITHEATER**

Located in the shadow of Lake Junaluska's iconic cross, the Amphitheater provides an expansive view of the lake and mountains.

# **COLONNADE**

A long, rose-lined walkway leads to the Colonnade, where vows can be exchanged against the backdrop of Lake Junaluska and the **Great Smoky Mountains**

# **SHACKFORD HALL**

An auditorium with wooden floors, high ceilings and a stage create a warm, grand setting for any ceremony or reception at Shackford Hall.

# **LAMBUTH INN LAWN**

The lawn outside historic Lambuth Inn offers panoramic views of the lake and mountains. A 30-by-45-foot white tent may be rented.

# **HARRELL CENTER 201 & BALCONY**

Located upstairs in the Harrell Center, guests especially enjoy a private outside patio area that overlooks the lake.

# Lake Junaluska Weddings FAQ

Q: How much time is allotted for ceremony & reception? A: Traditional wedding ceremony has a 4-hour time block and the reception has a 6-hour time block. An elopement wedding ceremony has a 2-hour time block. Time for decorating and removal of decorations should be figured into these time blocks.

Q: What is included with reception rental? A: All venue rental includes custom table/chair set-up, choice of white or black linens, dinnerware, flatware & glassware. Couples provide decorations in the space.

Q: Are audio/visual items available? A: Items such as sound system, microphone, and projector/screen are available to rent for an additional fee.

Q: Will a rehearsal be allowed? A: Yes, a 1-hour rehearsal at the selected venue is scheduled the day before the event at no additional charge. For planning purposes, the rehearsal time is set 90 days prior to event date.

Q: Can outside food be brought in to facility? A: Lake Junaluska is licensed to serve food at all of our venues and, for this reason, we do not allow outside food brought into our venues with the exception of a wedding/ specialty cake from a licensed bakery. All food must be ordered through our catering menu. Selections include plated meals, heavy hors d'oeuvres and full buffets. Our menu can accommodate special meals such as vegan, vegetarian, and gluten-free. Catering menu is available upon request.

Q: Are lodging room blocks available? A: Yes, a lodging room block is possible with a discounted rate. Room blocks are a good idea during summer and fall months when our hotels are busy. They are especially helpful for destination weddings. Speak to our Wedding Coordinator for more details.

Q: Is alcohol allowed on property? A: Beer, wine & champagne are allowed in private venues at Lake Junaluska. Our property and staff do not sell or serve alcohol, so please review Lake Junaluska Alcohol Policy. Wine and champagne glasses are available for rental.

Q: How are venues decorated? A: The decoration of any venue is up to the discretion of the bride and groom. All decorations must be removed at the end of the event. Only clean up what you bring to the venue; we take care of the rest!


Q: Are candles allowed in venues? A: Lake Junaluska asks that no open-flame candles be used in any venue. If candles are used as part of the decoration, they must be LED-lighted candles. Exception is a Unity Candle.

Q: What items are allowed during the bridal party farewell? A: Any items used during departure must be promptly cleared away by the bridal party as part of the clean-up process. Items such as glitter, rice, confetti of all types, silk petals, and open flame lanterns are not permitted. Please choose only biodegradable items to help protect our Lake and wildlife. Birdseed, bubbles & similar items work well.

Q: What is the booking process? A: After selecting venue(s), an Agreement is created. The party has 14 days to review the Agreement. All venues are held until the Agreement deadline. At the time of signing, a non-refundable 20% deposit based on venue rental and/or catering minimum will be due. After signing and receipt of deposit, the couple will work with a coordinator throughout the planning process.

Q: What is the cancellation policy? A: Once the Agreement is signed and deposit received, the signer is committed to a certain percentage of the rental and catering costs. Please read carefully the cancellation policy in the Agreement.

Q: In what areas does the coordinator assist? A: Rather than a Wedding Planner, the Lake Junaluska Wedding Coordinator works on behalf of the venue by assisting the couple with custom set-up of all venues, organizing catering, providing facility layouts and site visits as necessary, processing all payments. The coordinator is available throughout the planning process until the event date. References for Wedding Planners, Day-Of Coordinators and local vendors are available upon request.





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
