



The Asheville Treetops Adventure Park at the Adventure Center of Asheville

is an aerial challenge course in the trees that has over 77 unique climbing, rolling, walking, jumping, swinging, and rappelling challenges anchored to over 30 trees and towering poles tucked into a wooded park. These challenge elements are divided into 7 different aerial adventure trails ranging from beginner to challenging levels. There are several elements that are representative of the activities you can do in North Carolina including a sky kayak, a parkway tunnel, a snowboard in the sky, swinging hula hoops, bumper boats and a zip hang glider, all in the trees that make this great fun.

Before you start your adventure, we train you how to use our state-of-the-art equipment with a fun training video and an equipment fitting (full body harness, helmet, and safe lock clips.) We use a new technology called "smart belays" that, when used properly, are designed to assure Park Guests are attached to safety systems at all times and **cannot detach** from the system until they have completed the aerial trail and are back on the ground. Guests can explore freely knowing the safety system monitors their attachments and is designed to not allow accidental unclipping from the safety points.

The Treetops Park is Challenge by Choice! Adults and youth age 15 and older can **choose** between our lower trails (Green & Blue) or our Intermediate Trails (Yellow & Orange) or our Expert Trails (Red & Black). Kids age 7-14 must choose between their age-appropriate trails. And kids age 4-6 will start on the Purple Trail (a trail that starts on the ground just for their size) then they have the option of climbing the Green and Blue Trails with an adult. We guarantee that everyone will get to climb at least 2 trails! We have a great adventure level for everyone!

Treetops Park booking information:

- **Max Weight Limit per person of 265 lbs.**
- Ages 4 and over (trail restrictions for younger ages- see below)
- Adult escorts/monitors are needed for younger children
 - **Escorts are paying/climbing adults** who are 18 years and over. (Not required to be legal guardian.) Monitors are watching adults who may stay on the ground.
 - Ages 4-6 require a 1:1 adult escort to climb the Green and Blue (lower level) trails. They start on the Purple Trail by themselves, then have the option to go on the Green or Blue.
 - Ages 7-9 require an adult escort to climb the Yellow and Orange Intermediate Trails. One adult can take 2 kids. But kids can climb the Green and Blue Trails by themselves with an adult monitoring.
 - Ages 10-12 require an adult escort to climb the Red Course (upper trail). One adult can take 2 kids. But they can climb the Blue, Green, Yellow and Orange by themselves.
 - Ages 13-14 can climb all the trails independently except the Black Trail (highest and longest trail). To climb the Black Trail, they need a 1:1 adult escort.
 - Ages 15 and over can climb all the trails independently.
- 2 hours of adventure includes ground school and climbing
- Guests must be able to walk on challenge elements like swinging bridges, climb steps, and balance. While, the beginner trails are not strenuous, they do require the participant to have balance and some flexibility. Guests should not climb if they have a sprained/broken bone or muscle or are pregnant.
- **This is not a zipline course. It is an adventure park with aerial trails filled with challenge elements.**

Weather

We do go rain or shine. If there is a storm or storm forecasted, we expect guests to show up on time, unless we have called to cancel. If there is an actual lightning storm, we are watching the radar and may delay the trip time or get everyone down to the ground who is currently climbing. But we treat that as a delay and expect guests to be on time.

Group Reservation Information

- Group reservations are confirmed with a deposit to hold your activity time.
- The final number of participants and full payment must be given to group sales at least 7 business days prior to activity date.
- You will be charged for your confirmed number of participants, unless you purchase our cancellation guarantee.

Cancellation Information

The Adventure Center of Asheville is open rain or shine year-round.

- Cancellation 14 days in advance of activity date- full refund will be given except for one \$10 reservation fee for activity
- Cancellation between 14 and 7 days in advance of activity date -\$20 per person cancellation fee for activity
- Cancellation less than 7 days from activity date- no refunds for reservation cancelled unless cancellation guarantee is purchased.
- Rescheduling is treated as a cancellation.
- No refunds for inclement weather.

Optional Cancellation Guarantee:

- For a nonrefundable 7.5% fee, full refund will be given for any reservation cancelled by 1pm the day before the activity date.
- Full credit in form of a voucher, except the fee, will be given for an activity cancelled the same day, prior to activity time.
